Curd it be true? Student cheese makers on par with professionals

Students from two Greater Brisbane schools had a lot to smile and say cheese about today, receiving rave reviews from the judges at the Royal Queensland Show's (Ekka) Student Made Cheese Competition Awards at the Brisbane Showgrounds.

St Aidan's Anglican Girls' School in Corinda won the Mould Ripened Cheese White category for the very first time, with their entry titled Lily.

Judge Mark Livermore said it was a beautiful cheese.

"The cheese scored a 19 out of 20 and that would get a gold medal at any competition in Australia," he said.

Meanwhile, Caboolture State High School won the Mould Ripened Cheese Blue category for the second consecutive year with their Jai entry.

"The cheese had a beautiful flavour with a good distribution of blue mould throughout it and was once again a gold medal cheese," Mr Livermore said.

Chief Judge Russell Smith said the quality of the cheeses produced in the competition over the past few years had been exceptional.

"The best cheeses we judged this week were as good as the commercial cheeses you can buy," he said.

"This year we saw lots of well marbled blue cheeses, which we don't often see as it's hard to achieve a nice vein."

Flagstone State Community College also took home a blue ribbon, winning the Ekka's Agricultural Sciences and Student Fermented Beverages Competition.

The school's Triple LBJ group claimed the title of Champion Fermented Beverage for their ginger beer.

Entries across the two competitions were up 25 per cent on last year, with a total of 237 entries received from 31 schools.
