Tomorrow, the iconic Grand Parade triumphantly returns after being postponed for the first time in more 40 years due to wet weather on People's Day.

With the most Ekka-perfect weather you could wish for, tomorrow also sees the crowning of the grand champions in canine and sheep, the unearthing of the next country music stars, while one of Australia's most popular children's entertainers Emma Memma takes the stage.

Today, a cracking crowd flocked to the Show and by night's end more than 40,000 will have soaked up the sun and enjoyed a fabulous Friday of fun as the Dairy Queens reigned supreme on the Main Arena.
